

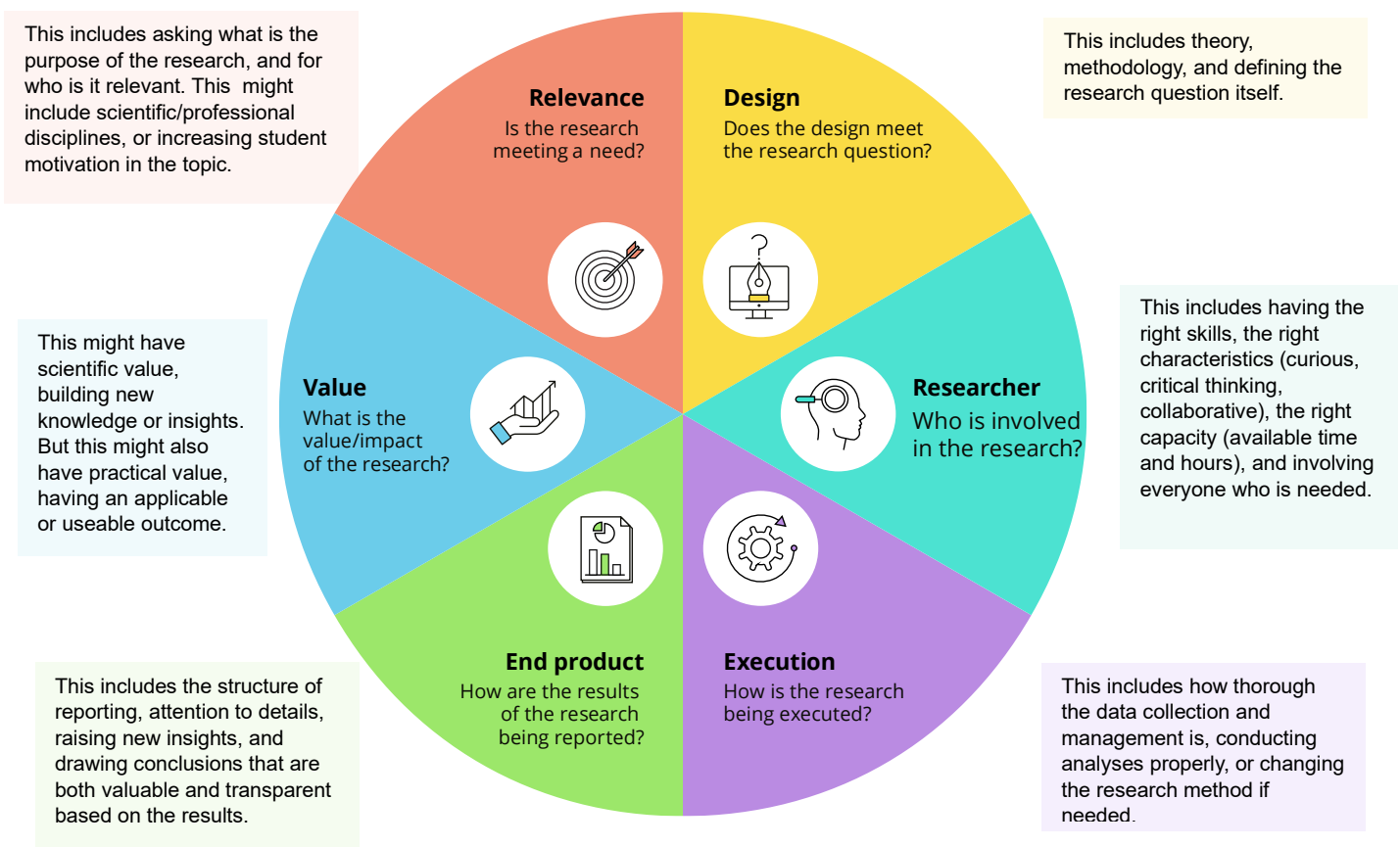
# Quality of Research Instrument

## Aim

While many people aspire for quality research, there are different understandings of quality, priorities within a team, and perspectives about how to get there. This tool helps discuss these different ideas of quality.

## Quality of Research

Through our research, we asked lecturers across higher education institutions what they considered quality research to be. We heard different perspectives across the following themes:



By discussing each of these qualities within your team, you can identify strengths, areas for improvement and prioritise actions to take. There is no hierarchy to these qualities, or a particular order you have to discuss them in. Rather, each team will likely have different priorities and areas for improvement. You can adapt these discussions for your target group, for example within a teaching team, or at an organisational level.
